#### OT SEWER WORK

Sewer work on the corner of **Maple** and **Elmwood** will affect traffic in Oak Terrace from the end of March through August 2013.

The sewer lines must be redirected and the trench deepened by 80 feet at the pump housing on **Maple** Avenue. **Maple** will only be accessible from **Route 83** and will not allow through traffic to **Elmwood**. A portion of **Elmwood** will be closed to traffic during the process. Residents need to be aware that **once work starts traffic will** be restricted in this area.
